

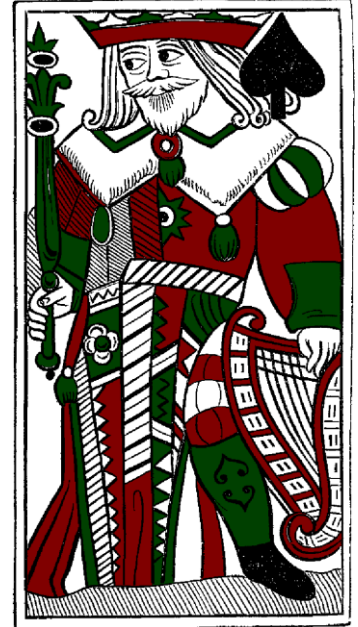
Bringing Alive Sandwich Heritage presents:

Following the success of our medieval **banquets**, BASH invites you to step into the Tudor period for an evening of **historic game playing**.

Experience the popular pastimes of the Renaissance period, with **reproduction board games, games of chance, strategy, dice and cards**. There will be games for teams, pairs and solo players, and something for every level of skill, from novice to card-sharp.

Game-playing was a popular form of entertainment in taverns and inns, courts and households, with people coming together to eat and drink, gamble and gossip. Musicians and players would often perform to the assembled company. In keeping with this tradition, BASH's **Tudor Games** will include **authentic live music** and **interludes**, with **refreshments** made to renaissance recipes and a **licensed bar**.

Guests will be greeted with a **warming glass of mulled wine**, and **complimentary sweetmeats and suckets** will be served during the evening.

The event will take place in the atmospheric oak-panelled Grand Jury Room of Sandwich's historic Guildhall. Period **costume** is actively encouraged!

Doors open at 8pm. Licensed bar - over 18s only.
